

- On April 5th will start the phasing in of our full 5-day on-site learning.
- We are finalizing the details to this plan to ensure a safe and orderly return.
- On April 5<sup>th</sup> ALL students in cohorts A, B, and C (that means groups 1 and 2) will be onsite 4 full days, Wednesday will still be remote.
- And during the following week of April 12<sup>th</sup>, we will have a full 5-days of on-site learning for cohorts A, B, and C. 5-day onsite learning will remain in effect until the end of the school year on June 21<sup>st</sup>.
- Cohort D or Remote students that are interested in returning to full 5-day on-site learning will remain remote until at least April 29<sup>th</sup>, as we will need time to adjust to the larger capacity of students in the building.
- Cohort D families that are interested in returning to 5-day learning should complete the parent survey that can be found on the KMS website or email your respective assistant principal to make arrangements.
- Dual enrollment students will begin to attend classes at New Bedford High School. I am still working with NBHS to finalize the details. Be sure to check your emails and answer your calls for more information.
- A message to all parents, please check your emails, Classdojo messages and listen to the robocalls carefully for more information. There will be more information coming.
- Parents, please know that students must wear their masks and stay at least at a 3-foot distance from others, this is not negotiable and failure to follow this direction will result in removal.
